The following courses were deferred:

• Computer Science Program (9:00am TIME CERTAIN) Mod Bill Wolfe, Peter Smith, AJ Bieszczad, and Steve Lefevre attended the meeting to discuss the CS Program proposal. The committee expressed its earlier concern on additional units to the major. Basically, the proposal is proposing an increase in elective requirements to give students a broader selection of courses that the program feels is necessary to prepare our CS students with the breadth they need required in industry. They supported their position by noting other CSUs with similar unit requirements. Phil Hampton also noted that the minor did not meet the STEM requirements of 9 upper division units. Steve Lefevre noted the Chancellor's focus on keeping units limited to 120 units. He suggested that the increase in units might wait until the program's external review occurs next fall. The following items will be the focus of an amended program: 1) Change to 125 units by moving the Math requirement, address the upper division requirement lacking in the minor, and 3) address the overall unit count in the program self-study.
