ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation is

ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, CHANNEL ISLANDS, INC.

ARTICLE II Corporate Status

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is being organized under the provisions of the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law of the State of California for public purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to operate exclusively for the benefit of, to perform the functions of, and to carry out the purposes of California State University Channel Islands for the education and advancement of its student members.

ARTICLE III Conformity With Law

This Corporation shall be an auxiliary organization of the California State University, and shall conduct its operations in conformity with the California statutes governing such organizations (Chapter 7, commencing with Section 89900, of Part 55, Division 8, Title 3 of the Education Code) and the Regulations established by the Board of Trustees of the California State University (Subchapter 6, commencing with Section 42400, of Chapter 1, Division 5 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations) as required by Education Code, Section 89900(c).

ARTICLE IV Exempt Status and Limitations on Activities

This corporation is organized exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in or intervene in any political campaign (including publishing or distributing of statements) on behalf of opposition to any candidate for public office. provision of these Notwithstanding any other articles, corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
