The University Glen Development

The University Glen Development was created with the objective of implementing an employee-housing ownership program on the CSUCI campus designed to strengthen and promote the educational purposes and programs of CSUCI. This goal has been fostered by the creation of a diverse residential community based on the development of continually affordable housing that will assist in the recruitment, retention and productivity of faculty and staff. University Glen is comprised of forsale housing units, rental units, a Town Center and various amenities throughout the development. Home prices and rental rates are below the market in Ventura County.





Issues facing the residents of
University Glen are presented to the
staff of University Glen through the
Homeowners Advisory Council. The
Homeowners Advisory Council is
made up of five elected homeowners
who serve two-years representing
the homeowners. The council
advises University Glen on issues of
importance to the homeowners and

also approves architectural changes requested by homeowners.

Pool, work-out equipment, walking paths, parks, pet areas, and expected future additional pool and park.






