A California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation

- I. The name of the corporation is The Sustainability Council of Ventura County.
- II. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is organized is to provide educational programs and materials to the public that promote awareness and implementation of principles of sustainability in Ventura County.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
