

Digital Training Offered to Local Students

WHO: Local junior high and high school students

WHEN: Session 1, Monday, July 31 - Thursday, Aug. 3, 10 a.m. - noon

WHAT: At the above place and time, the University will host the Teen Summer Workshops, two four-day sessions on digital workshops for local junior high and high school students, free and open to the public and sponsored by the CSUCI Library and the Oxnard Public Library. Working closely with CSUCI Library media staff, participants will learn to design and produce their own Web sites, posters and movie-clip previews of a popular Hollywood creature film.
