

Fall 2006 Enrollment Deadline Is Nov. 30

Camarillo, Calif., October 17, 2005 - The deadline for priority enrollment for the fall semester of 2006 at California State University Channel Islands is November 30, 2005. Enrollment is open to first-time freshmen, upper division transfers with 60 transferable units, and to those pursuing second baccalaureate degrees and teaching credentials, according to Jane Sweetland, CSUCI dean of Enrollment Services. In addition, on campus housing is available to a limited number of admitted students on a first-come, first-serve basis.

While the total number of CSUCI students this academic year is approximately 2,500 students, the University anticipates a total of approximately 3,000 for the 2006-07 academic year. Last year, the University closed to freshman applications on December 1, Sweetland said.

CSUCI currently offers undergraduate degrees in art, biology, business, chemistry, computer science, economics, English: Literature and Writing, environmental science and resource management, history, liberal studies, mathematics, psychology, sociology, and Spanish. Students may now also apply for performing arts and political science, available for the 2006-07 academic year.

Administrative services, education specialist, multiple subject, and single subject, and special education teaching credentials are also offered.
