

CSUCI 2007 Commencement Ceremony Draws More Than 7,500

Camarillo, Calif., May 24, 2007 - California State University Channel Islands hosted its fifth Commencement ceremony on May 19, 2007. The Class of 2007 included members of CSUCI's Inaugural Freshman Class, students who enrolled as the first freshmen at the University.
