Dear Campus Community:

Yesterday we responded to an incident involving one of our students on campus. I must emphasize again that we believed that the campus community was never at risk. However, prudence and concern for everyone's safety dictated that we take immediate action with regards to this student-made threat.

I am extremely proud of our campus Emergency Operations Center. This group worked efficiently to ensure everyone's safety as well as the campus' proactive approach of notifying the campus community and media outlets concerning the facts of the situation.
