Art sale hours are Thursday, Dec. 9 from 4 to 8 p.m., Friday Dec. 10 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturday, Dec. 11 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

A portion of the sales will be donated to the University's Foundation to support the CI Art Program gallery exhibitions throughout the campus and surrounding communities.
