MISSY LIBRARIAN'S TIP OF THE DAY!

If you have 5 minutes today, get your library card at the Circulation Desk. All you need is your student ID card... We'll slap a barcode on it and you're all set!



WHAT'S UP WITH THAT \$7.50 WHEN I LOGIN?

That's your Papercut account with a \$7.50 credit. Your papercut account is automatically credited at the beginning of each semester. When you print off the library printers, papercut will deduct money per copy (i.e., per impression or per side). It's \$0.05 cents per black/white print and \$0.20 cents per color print.

If you run out of printing money before the end of the semester, you can add money to your account at the Circulation Desk. Library accepts cash, check, Master Card, American Express, and Discover. Sorry, no coins, ATM, or Visa, and we are no longer accepting paper reams.

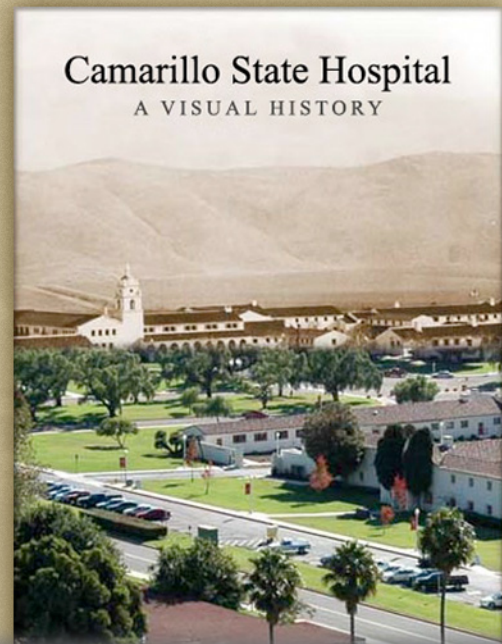
