The Commissioners prepared 2,000 Tri-fold Registrations for mailing during the 3-hour meeting. Commissioner Hillbrant brought the Tri-fold Registrations, Commissioner Phillips prepared and presented the 2,000 labels and Commissioner Pallant provided the other needed supplies. Commissioners were invited to the CSU CI walk through Monday, March 3 at 11:30 where the Forum will be held.

Commissioner Pallant advised Commissioners to use the new mailing address, 4360 E. Main Street, #460, Ventura, CA 93003, when they print their next business cards.

Commissioner Howard presented a Report on the Advisory Board Guidelines and thanked Commissioner Hurd for her assistance. Commissioners discussed adding to the protocol the following: that the Advisors are non-voting, honorary positions; that stationary (letter-head) positions will be rotated subject to available space; members would be prominent women who serve on major boards, elected officials who support women's issues, and who need not have a presence in Ventura County; Gender will not be an issue; recommendations are to come from Commissioners to the Advisory Board Sub-Committee. The Sub-Committee will deliberate and present their recommendations to the Commission. The following Commissioners volunteered to serve on the Advisory Board Sub-Committee: Ina Howard, Carmen Hurd, Janet Barron, Shante Morgan-Durisseau, and Nancy Lee Phillips. By general consent Commissioners approved placing on the April Agenda the Advisory Board protocol revision to the Standing Rules and making it a Standing Committee when Bylaws are reviewed in June.

Commissioner Phillips moved and Commissioner Lawrence seconded to approve the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding by the Chair Pallant with the Ventura County Human Services Administration – Children & Family Services with these requested changes: That 3.d. to add, "and hosting VCCW website domain VCCW.Net on the County Server;" to change the number 13 to 15; and to confirm internet access by the VCCW computer. The motion passed.

Guest Nancy Ballard, Ventura County Public Health Director of the Adolescent Family Life Program (AFLP) spoke to the Commissioners about the TSPP Program and was introduced by Commissioner Guizar. Follow-up meetings will be held by the TSPP Committee with Nancy Ballard in March.

Commissioner Barron lead the discussion with members on the 2008-2009 Project Planning Table and reviewed the Retreat material. Chair Pallant expressed appreciation for Barron's work on the Table and Retreat Material.

Chair Pallant reported on informing the Supervisor Foy of the vacancy in his district with the resignation of his appointee Emmanuelle Lipsky, and assisting in its formal recognition.

Chair Pallant reported on her effort to get a March date-certain for the Board of Supervisors recognition of Women's Herstory Month which will be co-sponsored by AAUW who wish to collaborate with VCCW. Commissioner Phillips will email the National Women's History Questionnaire to Commissioners to take to their libraries in March.
