Commissioner Pallant lead the members in reviewing the 2006-2007 Project Planning Table. Members discussed and devised a Budget Development Plan for which Commissioner Pallant agreed to serve as lead and other members accepted assignments; Commissioner Morgan Durisseau was added to the Newsletter task; Volunteer Karen Peters has taken the lead on updating the website; the 2008 CalWORKS presentation "goody bag" was contributed to by Dennis Phillips and there was discussion of having the honorees filmed or photographed for part of that presentation; Commissioner Fargo has kept members updated on CAWA, CEDAW, and State Commission Alerts; Commissioner Morgan Durisseau has taken the lead in developing the Publicity Plan; Commissioner Guizar has taken the lead on the TSSP project; Commissioner Phillips will distributed the amended Bylaws to members and the list of assignments for the Budget Development Plan.

By general consensus the Planning Retreat date was set for Saturday, October 20 at the home of Commissioner De Vries, 4800 Oceanaire, Oxnard on the corner of Harbor and Oceanaire. A No-Host lunch will be catered. Lisa Chadwick Peterson was asked to facilitate.
