

Feedback from Dawn Neuman Regarding STEM Initiative Task Force, 12/10/09

Ching reported to Dawn about the STEM Initiative Task Force meeting on Dec. 8, 2009.

Amy and Ching were at the meeting. Together, they decided that the two reports from Jeanne Drier and Amy Denton would be due by the end of the first week of February, 2010, which would leave enough time for the Task Force members and general faculty to make comments during the following week and final completion of the reports to Dawn by Feb. 15, 2010.

Dawn was glad to hear about the two reports and believed that these were important for the establishment of the STEM Institute.

The plan of action is that once Dawn receives the reports, she will then make a call to faculty volunteers to join the STEM Institute Task Force.

Dawn also informed Ching that there is a presidential group forming to work on STEM Initiative on campus. Dawn would recommend the members of the current STEM Initiative Task Force to become the members of the presidential STEM Initiative Group, which will also include members from Student Affairs, EPA, and Advising. She will create a charge for this group and would inform us the next step of action.
