

Statement on Conflict of Interest

California State University Channel Islands is committed to fair and lawful practices in all its business dealings. This goal is required by a framework of law and regulation, and moreover, by ethical and leadership values that are consistent with the University mission. Under the Political Reform Act of 1974 (Government Code Sec. 81000 et seq.), no CSU employee shall make, participate in making, or attempt to use his or her official position to influence a CSU decision in which he or she has a personal economic interest.
